“I am excited about working with kids in Bartlesville and the surrounding communities. With over 25 years of basketball camp experience, I have borrowed from the best and have developed a way of teaching kids the art of learning, not only the basics of the game, but I stress teaching the details it takes to be successful in the up-tempo, outside shooting, and physical game that basketball has developed into today. I would like to work and in hand with local high school programs by teaching basketball through our camps .”

Coach Donnie Bostwick has coached championship teams both at the high school and collegiate level. His teams rank in the top 5 annually in outside shooting, while having a reputation of overachieving in all areas of the game.

“Today’s game has changed, all five players on the floor need to learn how to shoot, handle the basketball, and play facing the basket.”

At the collegiate level he has coached six NAIA All-Americans including Brandon Cole, the all-time leading three-point shooter in the history of college basketball. For six straight seasons he has coached the nations leading three-point shooter.

“God has blessed me with the opportunity to coach some great players over the years. They have taught me as much as I was able to teach them. I look forward to sharing that knowledge and the Christian principles that can help young athletes become successful both on and off the floor.”

SHOOTING & ONE-ON-ONE CAMP - JULY 21-23

This camp is for boys and girls ages 9 to 18 who are ready to take their game to a new level. The camps runs 3 days and go from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. Kids will work against players in their age group.

Emphasis

SHOOTING—Details of developing a better shot such as footwork, quicker release, and learning the keys needed to be a great shooter. Using your shot to set up one-on one skills.

BALLHANDLING AND PASSING CAMP—MAY 26-27

With more emphasis placed on 5 on5 games and less emphasis on fundamental, there seems to be a trend of fewer good passers and/or ballhandlers. One or two players learn how to dribble and pass while other players suffer. This camp will help players become complete players.

DAY CAMP - June 9-12

These camps are for kids ages 9 to 14 who want to both learn the basics of the game and have fun with contest and competitions. Camps will run from 9 a.m. to 3 p.m. on Monday—Wednesday. Final Contest will begin at 11 am on Thursday with camp ending at noon.

Emphasis

Our goal is to make sure that teaching the game of basketball is done at a level that it is worth a parent’s investment, while at the same time the kids can have fun and compete in contest, as well.

LITTLE DRIBBLERS CAMP - MAY 23-24

This camp is new. It is for kids age 6-10. The emphasis is to help kids get a head start on their dribbling and passing skills.

DIAPER DANDY CAMP - JULY 24-25

This camp is for kids ages 4 to 8 years old. It is a unique opportunity for little kids to get hooked on basketball. Camp will run from 10 a.m. to noon each day.

Emphasis

By lowering the goals and breaking them into three groups—Small, Smaller & Smallest, we are able to make this an enjoyable experience for little kids as they learn the basics of dribbling and shooting. We have to have a few contests for the older kids but the emphasis is on participation and everyone leaving camp with a fun positive experience
